He died October 17, 2005 in Palm Springs, CA. Joe joined the U.S. Army Air Force, serving four years in the 432nd Bombardment Squadron in North Africa, Italy and Austria. With his long time friends, Dale Bennett and the late Bill Norstrom, Joe, founded and was the President of Cello Bag Company. It was one of the first companies to produce plastic bags for wholesale and consumer use. He was the innovator in the flexible plastic packaging industry.
